

#### Remote Control Systems / Techniques for Ham Radio Stations

The ARRL has a new (2010) publication (about 90 pages), Remote Operating for Amateur Radio: Ham Radio, the Internet and Remote Station Control, by Steve Ford, WB8IMY. This provides general coverage with specific references, but is somewhat sparse on actual "how to do it" details. It does briefly mention, almost in passing, the one of the newest, and apparently most effective, integrated hardware / software solutions, RemoteRig, produced in Sweden.
