#### WRTC-2006: Canadian Team Takes the Gold! US Teams Place Second and Third



(Jul 11, 2006) -- The Canadian team of John Sluymer, VE3EJ, and Jim Roberts, VE7ZO (ex-VE3IY), has officially topped the 46-team World Radiosport Team Championship 2006 (WRTC-2006) field with nearly 2.44 million points (see "WRTC-2006 Final Scores"). Operating as PT5M during the event, they will take home gold medals for the 2006 competition. US teams took the second and third positions for silver and gold medals respectively.

#### **FCC Invites Comments on Katrina Panel Recommendations**



(Jul 11, 2006) -- Comments are due Monday, August 7, in response to an FCC *Notice of Proposed Rule Making* (*NPRM*) regarding recommendations of the independent panel that reviewed Hurricane Katrina's impact on communication systems (EB Docket 06-119). Reply comments are due by Monday, August 21. "The Commission, in this proceeding, is to take the lessons learned from this disaster and build upon them

to promote more effective, efficient response and recovery efforts as well as heightened readiness and preparedness in the future," the FCC said. Some of the wide-ranging proposals in the *NPRM*, released in June, could affect the Part 97 Amateur Service rules. The FCC asked if should explore amending its rules to permit automatic grants of certain types of waivers or special temporary authority (STA) in declared disaster areas. After last year's devastating hurricanes, the FCC issued a handful of STAs to permit licensees lacking HF privileges to operate on HF for emergency purposes. The *NPRM* further offered three specific areas for consideration: Waiver of Amateur Radio and license-exempt rules, permitting transmissions necessary to meet essential communications needs; waiver of application filing deadlines, something the FCC did last fall for amateurs living in hurricane-stricken states; and a streamlined STA process. Interested parties may file comments and view the comments of others via the Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS). In either case, enter "06-119" in the "Proceeding" field (without quotation marks but including the hyphen).

#### **ARRL Has Seat on BPL Conference Panel**



(Jul 11, 2006) -- ARRL Laboratory Manager Ed Hare, W1RFI, will participate in an interactive audio conference, "Broadband over Power Lines: Is BPL Ready for Primetime?" Tuesday, July 11. Pike & Fischer is sponsoring the BPL event, which, for a fee, will permit individuals and groups to listen in and question the panelists. According to Pike & Fisher, the conference will explore the evolution of BPL and look into why companies like Goldman Sachs and Google have jointly invested approximately \$100 million in BPL ventures. The conference agenda includes an overview of some recent BPL deployments, challenges utilities face in BPL rollouts, potential BPL applications and revenue streams, the status of standards development, existing and emerging regulations affecting BPL, and the status of efforts to alleviate BPL's potential to interfere with Amateur Radio. Joining Hare will be Chano

Gomez of DS2, and Pete Griffin, chairman of the HomePlug Powerline Alliance. Moderating will be Scott Sleek, director of broadband advisory services, Pike & Fischer.

#### Forrest A. "Bart" Bartlett, W6OWP, SK



(Jul 11, 2006) -- Forrest "Bartl" Bartlett, W6OWP, of Paradise, California, died July 3. He was 92. For more than a half-century, W6OWP was the home of the ARRL code practice and West Coast Qualifying Run transmissions, provided for those unable to reliably copy W1AW. Licensed in the 1930s, Bartlett contributed several articles to QST between 1941 and 1995, including two on electronic keyer design in 1948 and 1951. Bartlett was a ham radio radioteletype (RTTY) pioneer. His friend Marvin Collins, W6OQI, says he and Bartlett may have enjoyed the longest-running RTTY schedule in the history of Amateur Radio.

#### Five Radio Amateurs Now Aboard the Space Station



(Jul 7, 2006) -- Five astronaut-hams now are aboard the International Space Station, and one of them -- European Space Agency astronaut Thomas Reiter, DF4TR -- has officially joined the Expedition 13 crew for the remainder of its duty tour and for about half of Expedition 14's tour -- six months in all, according to NASA. His arrival marks the first time since May 2003 that the ISS has had a three-member crew. Reiter and six other astronauts -- two of them also hams -- arrived July 6 aboard shuttle *Discovery*. The shuttle docked to the ISS July 6 at 1452 UTC.

Dubbed the "Scout Camps Calling Protocol," (SCCP), the plan aim to make it easier for scouts in the US and around the world to contact other scouts for Radio merit badge requirements, Amateur Radio demonstrations, emergency preparedness, passing traffic or to just get acquainted. The SCCP stemmed from a challenge ham-scouter Nathaniel Frissell, W2NAF, posed to members of the Scout Radio Yahoo discussion group to launch a summer camp net, so scouts could talk to one another.
