Some Possibly Interesting / Useful Information about Smith Charts


Hams who are interested in antennas, transmission lines and how to set things up to get an RF source to radiate an RF signal efficiently will quickly learn that this can a quite complicated subject. Fortunately, there are some very simple and straightforward ways to do things that work and it is possible to setup a ham station which works satisfactorily without understanding all of the theory. For those that want to understand this subject in depth, however, the math and the physics has never been easy, but use of a Smith Chart can make it easier.

My first encounter with Smith Charts was as a youngster when I took the Novice license written exam in the very early 1960s. That exam was administered by Howard / W1DG (SK), a senior engineer with Radio Free Europe at his dining room table in Connecticut. As I took the written exam, Howard was busy studying the 1960 QST Smith Chart article. When I asked him what the article was about, he answered Smith Charts and stated I would need to learn about them later. For those interested in reading about Smith Charts in ham radio, go to http://www.arrl.org/arrl-periodicals-archive-search and use the search term "Smith Chart".

I now fast forward (leaving out all intervening years and details about Smith Charts) to the 2014 Dayton Hamvention Forum on Smith Charts given by AE6TY, an MIT EE graduate and an early retired dot-com'er, who has devoted himself, among other things, to developing Smith Chart software. AE6TY has produced a very high quality, professional level graphical software which has been evolving and adding new features. Check out http://www.ae6ty.com/Smith_Charts.html for his AE6TY's software with video tutorials. Be sure to watch the video tutorials to learn how to use the software once you load it. Highly recommended!
