Ken was about half a mile down Mathis Avenue (near the intersection with Liberia Avenue) and Mark drove about a mile down Mathis Avenue (near the intersection with Sudley Road) and both were able to connect back to the library. They were using channel -2 (that is correct: channel "minus 2"), which is available to hams only, and not congested with commercial or consumer user router traffic.




