PRESIDENT'S LETTER:

Greetings everyone, Well, I was hoping we might get a winter this season without any of that nasty white stuff; but it seems like it's trying to make up for it with two storms almost back to back. Thankfully neither one is expected to be particularly nasty; a good reminder that it is, in fact, still winter here. The good news is that Spring is just around the corner although March can still pack a wintertime punch.

Getting the bad news out of the way first; the Hamfest Committee has made the very difficult decision to call-off the 2021 Manassas Hamfest in June. With large gatherings still being discouraged, or even restricted - even for those wearing masks, attempting to hold the Manassas Hamfest in June would be very risky for the OVH. It is unknown whether we would even be able to use our recent and usual location in June which is controlled by the City of Manassas Park. Even if Manassas Park were to allow that, something no one would know until the last moment, what would the attendance be? The Hamfest is a rather large financial gamble for the club; it takes quite a bit of money and other resources to put it together and the necessary efforts to put it on must start many months in advance, usually in the Fall of the previous year, when they started for this one. A good turnout at the Manassas Hamfest makes it worthwhile; but the poor turnout during a still ongoing pandemic might prove to be a loss. We will "pick it up again" later this year and plan for a Manassas Hamfest in June 2022; by then, hopefully, the COVID pandemic will be over. I'd like to thank Don / WA2SWX and the Hamfest Committee for all of the work put in beginning in the Fall of 2020.



Now, some much more positive news; this year the OVH scholarship will be given in memory of Steve / N4OGR. At the meeting last month, there was a discussion whether or not the OVH could afford to continue giving the scholarship given the

Minutes of the Ole Virginia Hams Amateur Radio Club Meeting held online on January 19, 2021:

The meeting was held online using the Jitsi platform hosted by OVH President, Jay / NQ4T. Since we were meeting virtually, Jay dispensed with the pledge and the members saying their callsigns, and Jay ran the meeting.

Ron / K3FR presented a program on the 6 meter indoor Moxon that he designed and build. Ron discussed materials, tools, construction and rotation with many pictures. He also discussed the Moxon vs other antennas and its radiation patterns and results on the January VHF contest. Ron's presentation is available on the web after member logon. W4ovh.net >membership > presentations.

The minutes of the November and December meetings were approved.

Treasurer's report sent by Don / WA2SWX and read by Jay was approved.

Luther WA3FMO gave the membership report. There were two new read-ins: Michael Frachel / KO4BCN and Robert Punihaole, Jr / KJ4EOR. These applicants for OVH membership will be read in at the next meeting.

Greg / KM4CCG gave the ARES report. There was a meeting last Saturday. Possible virtual meeting will take place in the future.

Mark / WA4KFZ gave the training report. He discussed the impact of the FRN requirement on future VE sessions and the new FCC fees for hams.

Ken / KE2N give the repeater report. The repeaters are working fine except the 220

which is waiting for covid restrictions to relax before reinstalling it. Ken documented how to turn off the repeaters in case of abuse and this has been sent to the repeater controllers. He discussed Fusion logging on the 442 repeater and noted that he found someone using it with a callsign of 10 zeros. This has been blocked. Ken also showed us how to get repeater recordings on Broadcastify and noted that he recently added the K4GVT repeater.

Hamfest report. No report. Hamfest is believed to be in somewhat of a holding pattern based upon continuing uncertainties about the COVID pandemic.

Scholarship report by Sandy / KM4JUS. She normally does not start the process until February.

Field Day report by John / KG4NXT and Theresa / KG4TVM. Winter field day will be held January 30th and 31st the at Shenandoah River State Park. Cabin 5 has been reserved. All OVH club members are invited to drop in to participate. More info in the Sunshine corner of the OVH January newsletter.

Theresa / KG4TVM gave the Sunshine report. Butch / W4HJL is out of the hospital. Al / KB4BHB is also out of the hospital. Jan / KE4TMW is also out of hospital. Theresa will contact her about a charitable donation for Steve / N4OGR, SK when things settle down.

Kevin / KX4KU gave the Web Committee report. John / KG4NXT is writing many of the web articles. No currently known problems.

New business:

Wayne / N4HCR mentions concerns about: 1) the recent Washington Post article about ham radio; that he contacted the Post about the alleged misuse of ham radio during the January 6, 2021 event at the Capitol in Washington DC; and 2) the new \$35 filing fee which will be due to the FCC for ham license applications.

John / KG4NXT suggested that the club should cancel the 2021 OVH scholarship because we had no income in 2020 from the cancelled Manassas Hamfest and may not have any for 2021. After discussion, this matter will be sent to the budget committee and the board for decision.

The meeting was adjourned.

Goals of the K3FR antenna project

- Horizontally polarized
- 6 meters directional with gain
- Good bandwidth (50.0 MHz to 52.0 MHz for < 2:1 swr)
- Low cost, simple materials, simple tools
- Integrate with existing Cushcraft A270-10S (5 el each on 2m & 70cm)
- Turning radius less than 65" (2 el Yagi = 66" turning radius)
- 50 Ohm coax feed

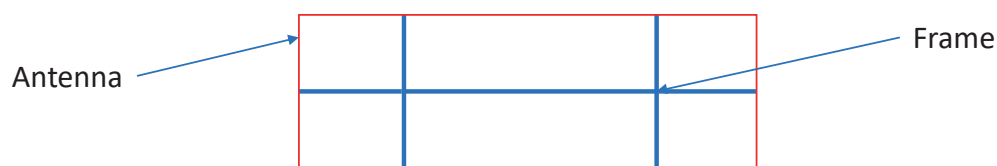
Note: Ron / K3FR's full presentation during the January 2021 OVH meeting used a total of 25 Slides. Just parts of several of them are presented here. If you want to look at or review all of the slides, go to the OVH's web site at W4OVH.NET Once there, go to the Membership menu and then to the Presentations submenu. You will need to log in as the Presentations items are only available to OVH members; of course, you can contact Ron directly too. .

What is a Moxon antenna?

- A 2 element Yagi (reflector and driven element)
 - The frontal lobe is broad 70° to 80°
 - The f/b ratio is quite good 25+dB but ...
 - It will not win a gain contest 9dB to 11dB (comparable to a small Yagi)
- The ends of the elements are bent back toward each other
 - Increases inter-element coupling
 - Mechanically shortens the elements
 - And, physically narrows the antenna (smaller turning radius)
 - Helps achieve a 50 Ohm feed point impedance through capacitive loading
- Note, there is little to be gained by adding director elements

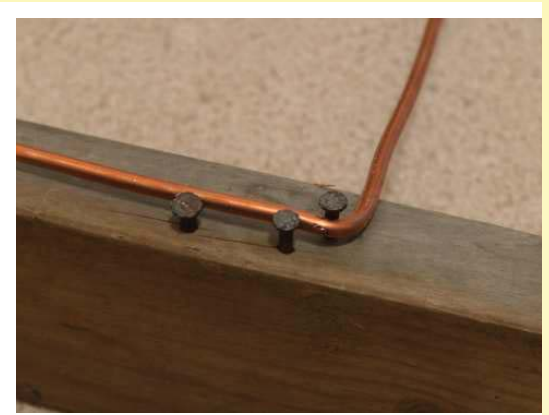
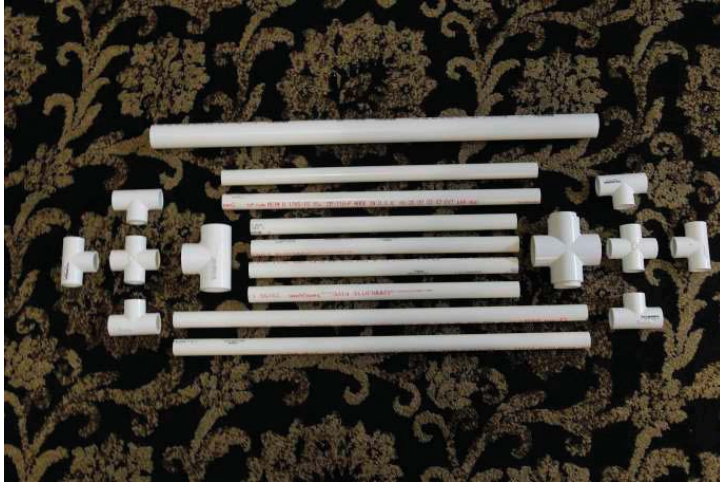
How do I support this much wire

- A lot of people use an "X" frame but there were issues:
 - Use of fiberglass arms
 - Needs a solid center support
 - The angles are not 90° or 45°
- I had seen a skeleton frame using PVC tubing in a YouTube video.

PVC Frame parts to support the wire.



Details of the feed point connection and element end spacers.



Just about ready. You must make the last reflector bend after inserting the wire in the frame.

Worm's eye view (just to be fair). Note the short tuning stub silhouetted by fan blade on left.



You may also tune the antenna by expanding the width a bit. That requires re-bending the wire.
