He further added he hoped that by becoming a ham operator, he could incorporate that into his physics lessons, too. This dovetails nicely into the Ole Virginia Hams Scholarships Program, which also seeks to promote STEM subjects among students. So, Michael and the OVH have overlapping goals. 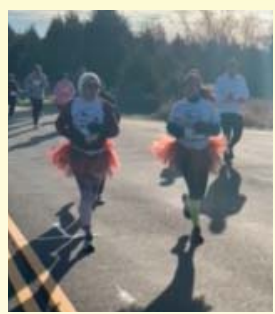

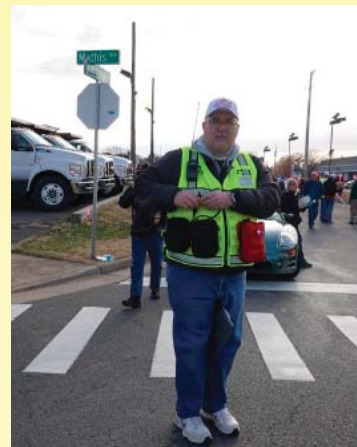
