# Minutes of the Ole Virginia Hams Amateur Radio Club Informal Meeting held on Monday, February 20, 2023:

OVH President Ken / KN4DD called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm on February 20, 2023 in the training room at the Buckhall Volunteer Fire Department Station. After the Pledge of Allegiance, all present stated their names and call signs.

Ken / KN4DD stated that it was election night and presented the known slate of candidates for OVH offices: Ken / KN4DD for President, Gil / KM4OZH for Vice-President, Don / WA2SWX for Treasurer and John / KG4NXT for Secretary. Ken then asked for additional candidates and no one responded. Ken then moved to elect the slate by acclimation and that motion passed unanimously.

Bruce / KN4GDX gave a program on a digital mode called VarAC. The slides will be posted on the OVH's web site under presentations on the Members-Only pages.

Gordon / NQ4K gave a presentation on the Virginia QSO party. He spoke about several 2023 rule changes including the new rover category. The slides from the presentation are available on the web.

#### POTA Activation of the Manassas National Battlefield Park

On Saturday, February 25, 2023, OVH members Al / KB4BHB, Don / WA2SWX, Gene / N4HFW and John / KG4NXT activated the Manassas National Battlefield Park by setting up and operating ham radio station(s) there.

We started our operations initially at the Visitor Center but the Park Rangers asked us to operate in the "Amateur Radio Area" in the picnic grounds off of Groveton road. As a result, we moved and set up there and were glad for the windbreak on one side of the picnic shelter. It was late February and cold and windy. We used Don's Wolf River Coil Vertical antenna with 3 radials. The transmitter was the digital







only QDX by QRP labs which put out 5 watts. We had an amplifier available but it would not key up. We needed a minimum of 10 contacts and got 11 so it was a successful POTA activation.

Once we got home, we found the problem with the Tokyo Hy Power HL-45b amplifier. It would not function with only 12 volts on the supply but was quite happy with 13 volts. John and Don returned to the Groveton picnic shelter on Sunday, February 26 and got the amp going for additional 18 contacts. Don used his 20 watt Xiegu G90 to make still 14 additional contacts.
