Ina has been living in Colorado and traveling back and forth between Colorado and Manassas for the last several years just to run this program and to be sure that the events go off without a hitch. If you ever wanted to see an energizer bunny in action, all you had to do was watch, or try to keep up with Ina.

Way back in 2014, Ina approached the OVH about providing radio communications

for the Mini Tri's. There were normally 5 to 6 events per year and they were all at the Freedom Center in Manassas. The OVH jumped at the chance to help out and was able to provide spotters and communications along the bike and run routes. We provided this support uninterrupted from 2014 until October 15th of this year.

We were able to staff these events with our club volunteers and once in a while we would recruit a few other hams in the area. There were usually anywhere from 5 to 10 volunteers at each event. If you were able to turn out to help, you could clearly see Ina's dedication to participants, as well as her appreciation that we were her eyes and ears on the course.
