On December 31, 1999 to January 1, 2000, there is a possibility that the Fauquier County Emergency Communications will be unable to function as designed. With this in mind, FARA has offered to provide amateur radio operators to provide the necessary communications to the fire, rescue and sheriff radio systems.

FARA will start around 6 PM on 31 DEC and it could be a 12-hour initial period. Volunteers are needed to help with this situation. The time is fast approaching.

Currently, there are only 10 of us that have signed up. This means that those 10 will be working a possible 12-hour shift. Twelve hours, or more, of operation will be very hard on the people who have already signed up to participate! I'd sure like to limit the shifts to 6 hours if possible.

FARA needs others to be ready in case the operation extends beyond the initial period. PLEASE, step forward and volunteer. Rearrange your schedule if you can. You'll be safer doing this than being on the roads.

Our response to this request will have a long lasting affect.

(Editor's Comments: Folks, this is what ARES (Amateur Radio EMERGENCY Services) is all about. This is what you have been training for by participating in public service events and Field Day and by taking the training sessions when they have been offered.

The changeover from December 31, 1999, to January 1, 2000, could cause widespread problems in the communications systems of ALL fire, rescue, State and Local police and sheriff offices. This is not an imagined scenario. . this is REAL. And, should our services prove unnecessary, at the very least, we will have the knowledge that we can and will be able to naticle a situation of this size should one ever arise and so will the County and the individual offices within the County.)


