




Sunshine Corner

Good Bye to OVH Packet Operations!

The last surviving OVH Packet radio digipeater was decommissioned in December to make way for the new 2 meter D-Star equipment in the equipment shed at Mt. Pone. In the mid-1980's the packet radio mode on VHF seemed to come out of nowhere; it quickly became very popular because of its novelty and its effectiveness for direct keyboard to keyboard communications and several other intriguing variations Highly useful systems such as DX Packet Cluster networks, packet radio based BBS's with (now primitive) email forwarding features using amateur radio packet networks and APRS nets evolved quickly. DX Packet Cluster systems allowed almost instantaneous circulation of DX spots to DXers on the cluster network; such radio based systems still exist and are supported, but have largely been supplanted by Internet based DX spotting networks. Packet radio based BBS's, on the other hand, have all but died out with the almost universal adoption of modern Internet based email. Other specialized packet based radio systems such as APRS still survive. Those who used packet in its heyday will have fond memories, but also recognize that it is now essentially an obsolete mode except for a few very specialized uses.


