#### REPEATER:

The repeater has been functioning normally for the last month. The C.W. identifier was fixed by Walt, WB4TBO and is now sending error free code again. The problem was dirty contacts on a relay and was corrected by

replacing the relay.

The new Phelps-Dodge commercial grad antenna has been installed on the tower. It is a four dipole array capable of 6 db omnidirectional gain. All users have reported a great improvement in performance over the old antenna. The antenna appears to be well made and should last a long time without maintenance.

No work has been done on updating the controls to solid state. However, winter is approaching with its shorter days and work will begin soon.
