Minutes of the Ole Virginia Hams Amateur Radio Club Meeting held on January 22, 2025:

OVH President Ken / KN4DD called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm on January 22, 2025 in the training room at the Buckhall Volunteer Fire Department Station. After the Pledge of Allegiance, all present stated their names and call signs.

Gil / KM4OZH gave the presentation about the coming OVH Meshtastic Node at Mt. Pone. He passed around the box ready to be mounted. Ken / KE2N brought additional hardware and explained the bandpass filter selection. The slides are on the OVH website under Presentations.

The minutes of the November 19, 2024 meeting were approved.

Jeff / K9VEG gave the treasurer's and it was approved.

Luther / WA3FMO gave the membership report. There was one vote-in and he was voted in: Wayne Lloyd, no call yet; and there was one read in: There was one read-in: Bettie St.Clair, no call yet.

ARES report: No report.

Repeater Report. Ken / KE2N advised that all repeaters are working. There is a problem with the 220 machine and it needs a software change at NOVEC. Ken will work on this and also to understand (and hopefully remedy) the random keying behavior of the 220 machine. One new member was approved for DStar.

Training Report: Mark / WA4KFZ advised that a VE session is scheduled but so far no one has contacted him about that.

Web Site Report. Ken / KN4DD advised attacks continue but the software defenses are holding. IP addresses indicate many of the attacks are from Russia, but IP addresses can be spoofed. Reasons for the attacks are unknown. Most appear to be by robots.

Tailgate Party Report. John KG4NXT advised he will chair it this year only. There was a January planning meeting. John and Theresa will go to Middle Peninsula hamfest on February 1st.

Field Day – Butch / W4HJL has reserved the Nokesville pavilion but the permit stated dawn to dusk. John will call Jane E. to try to avoid the Ranger Hawkins problem that we had last year. Chair Cat has called a planning meeting for February 5th and it is listed on the club web site.

Additionally, Jeff and Gil recently added another tower (to the right) which can be tilted down using torque from an electric drill. (John/KG4NXT)

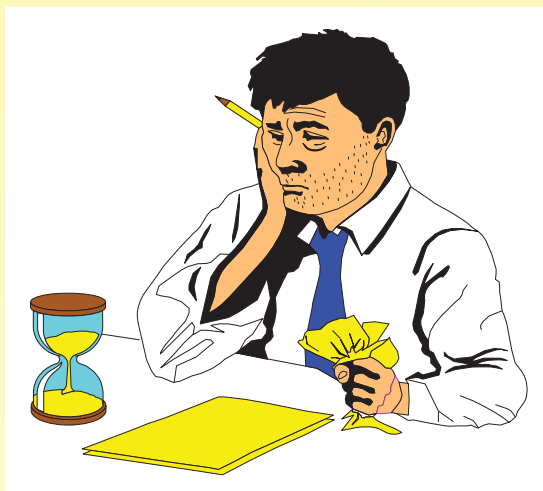


Report on the Middle Peninsula Hamfest
