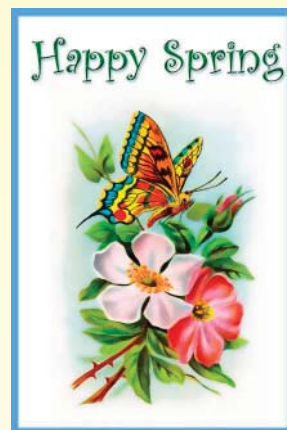
Special thanks to Ham Radio Outlet (HRO) in Woodbridge. They have a stack of our TailGate flyers in the front of their shop for people to take.

Vienna Wireless' Winterfest on March 9, 2025

On March 9, 2025, OVH had a table at Vienna Wireless Club's Winterfest. Some Possibly Interesting or Useful Information

At the upcoming OVH meeting there will be a presentation about the National Weather Service's SKYWARN program. Many hams participate in SKYWARN; participants first receive special training to enable them to provide independent weather spotter reports of severe weather to NWS' local Weather Forecast Office(s). Because knowing proper weather terminology and procedures for making (and reporting) helpful weather observations is crucial for this activity, most SKYWARN participants need special training. Many, free online training resources exist. For example, see, <https://weather.gov/spotterguide> which offers basic training. See also, https://weather.gov/iwx/online_spotter_training which provides pointers to many more very helpful and free resources, including those of the METED program at UCAR.edu. The URL for METED is <https://meted.ucar.edu/index.php>. To get access to specific METED courses, one must first sign up with an email address, a user name and a password; getting access is completely "free" and worth doing to get access to hundreds of online meteorology subject courses at all learner levels. The several courses specifically for SKYWARN can easily be found by searching for "SKYWARN" at METED.
