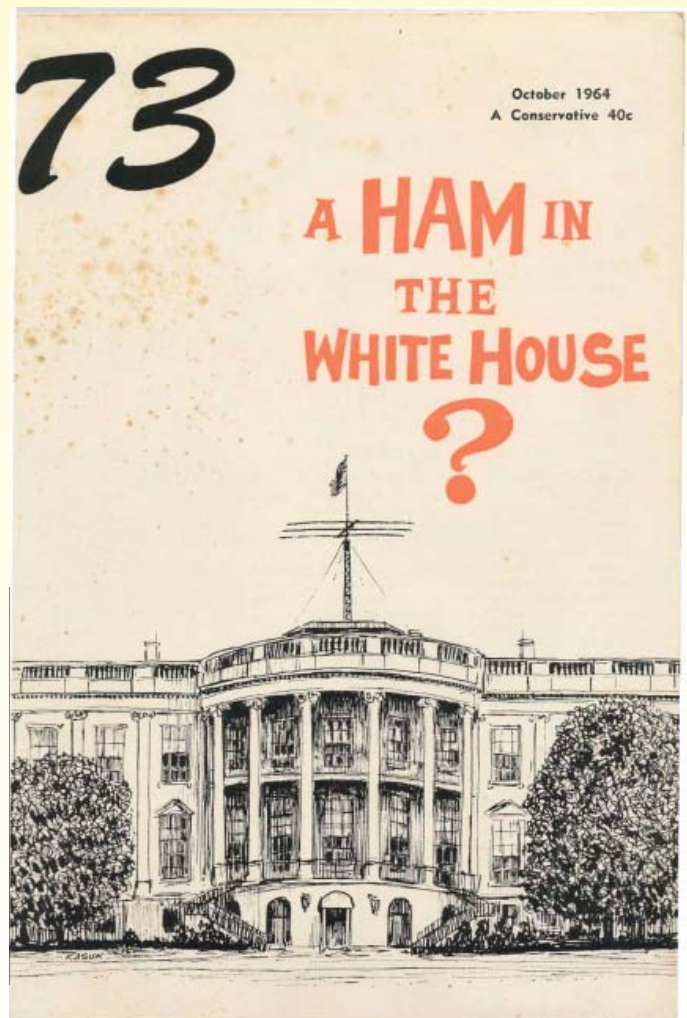

Some Possibly Interesting or Useful Info

It is very rare for a ham radio operator to become the chief executive of a major country.

In the US, Senator Barry Goldwater / K7UGA lost in a landslide in the 1964 presidential election to President Lyndon Johnson. Johnson was JFK's vice president who became president when JFK was assassinated in November 1963. K7UGA continued to be a very active ham and could be heard (and worked) regularly while operating HF mobile from his car in Washington D.C. in the 1960s and 1970s. The publisher of 73 Magazine, Wayne Green / W2NSD/1, held out hope to the very end that K7UGA would become president. See the October 1964 73 Magazine cover from the 73 Magazine archive, the URL for which in the left margin. That archive includes a complete set of all 73 Magazines published from 1960 until 2003, and is an excellent reference source for the history of ham radio developments during that period.

Right now it appears Friedrich Merz, DK7DQ, will be chosen to be Chancellor (Prime Minister) of Germany in May, but there is still some doubt. DK7DQ is reputed to have been a high speed CW and SSB HF operator when he was younger.
