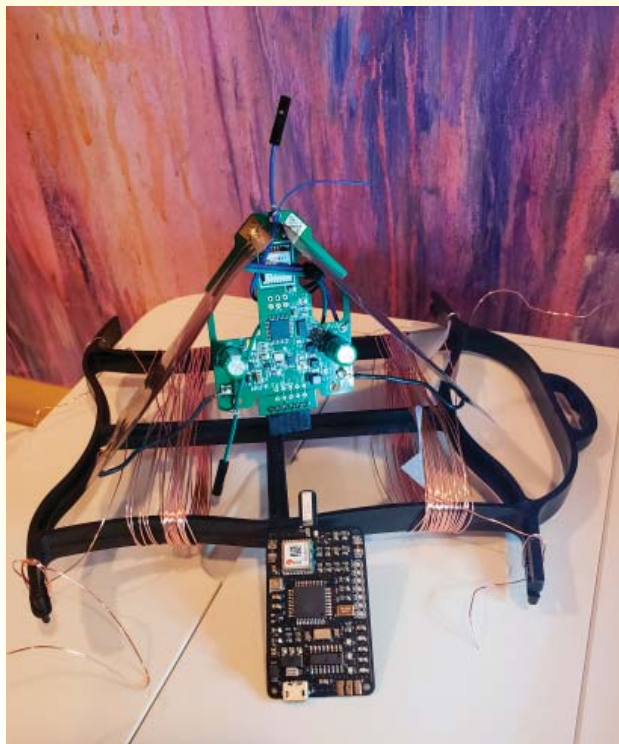

### Preview for the Amateur High Altitude Balloon (HAB) Launches Planned for 15:00 local time at W4OVH Field Day - June 28, 2025

Two amateur payloads are being prepared for the Field Day 2025 launch; currently planned for ~1500 on June 28 at the field day W4OVH site.

The first is similar to the 2024 HAB payload launch. It is a WSPR payload programmed for the 20 meter band. The payload is sitting next to its 20 meter dipole antenna and is currently being tested. Power is supplied by two solar panels, seen edge-on here, and backed up with two super capacitors which are seen here as the large components on the board. At launch, the payload is suspended between the two 17 foot legs of the 20 meter dipole.

The lower board in this view is the second payload. It is currently planned as a second

balloon launch. The board contains an APRS payload which will transmit through a 50 cm antenna on the 2 meter APRS frequencies. The antenna is attached downward from the board; and the GPS receiver is on the upper edge of the board. The power source and physical attachment is currently being evaluated, but will likely be a solar panel and super capacitor arrangement similar to the WSPR payload. Programming the payload's on-board computer is done with the Arduino IDE using a payload and board-specific application. The programming effort is underway and will be followed by constructing the power source and then testing on 'live' APRS receivers.

Each payload weighs about one ounce, including GPS receivers and antennas. The balloons are planned to be 48 or 72 inch latex.

The weather conditions on Field Day will determine the "go" or "no-go" decision for the launches since rain and/or heavy winds will compromise the launch process. As in 2024, the balloon lift will be provided by hydrogen gas. An improved loading system has been developed and is also being leak-tested with the actual launch balloons and compressed air.
