We had a table for the OVH and our primary purpose there was to distribute OVH flyers for the upcoming 2026 Manassas Hamfest on June 20th.



## Two Recent Operating Awards Earned by John / KG4NXT




### Some Possibly Interesting or Useful Information

1. Those interested in radio contesting know that observing good “etiquette” during contest events is important. What’s involved and what does that mean? See, DX Engineering’s blog: <https://www.onallbands.com/guide-to-january-2026-ham-radio-contests-good-etiquette-edition/> for a fairly complete discussion of this important subject for contesters.

2. A very interesting presentation about the HamClock hardware and software systems was made by John / KG4NXT to the OVH in the Fall of 2024. Unfortunately, the HamClock developer, Elwood Downey, WB00EW, recently passed away; as a result, the HamClock system is now scheduled to stop working in June 2026 when its backend servers are shut down. The good news is that a very closely related system known as OpenHamClock has been developed and will be the successor to HamClock thanks mostly to K0CHN. The new OpenHamClock system will also have expanded capabilities. See, <https://openhamclock.com> for more details about this and how to avoid future problems with HamClock systems.

3. Want to learn the basics of ham radio mostly using a comprehensive set of online videos? The DARC (German Amateur Radio Club) has been supporting a web site [<https://50ohm.de/>] which does just that with an extensive set of videos and other materials which are primarily oriented to assisting newcomers in passing the ham radio licensing exams in Germany. So what possible use can this be to me you think initially because you don’t know or speak any German and have no need for a German ham license in the USA! Think again I say and take even just a quick look at <https://50ohm.de> in a modern web browser to see what is now available online. When you first go to <https://50ohm.de> using your American English language based web browser set to use Google for search, etc., Google will ask you if would like the web pages translated to English. Click “Yes” and be amazed immediately how all of the text on each page is suddenly converted to readable, understandable and fluent American English! Select and start one of the videos, almost all of which are recorded in German only, but plan to fiddle a bit with the CC (closed captions) and Language Settings in the Youtube video player. You can, of course, get closed captions in German text and hear the video narration in German. But once you get the proper settings, the closed captions will be in fluent American English (converted in real time from the German text) and the video narration will also be in real time by an almost natural sounding (robot) speaker of American English based upon the converted closed caption text. This is amazing, but be forewarned, the AI translation system is not yet converting the video of the narrator’s lip movements to the spoken American English! Ham Radio is an international hobby and most of the up to date content at this web site is pertinent to a newcomer or learner in the USA.
