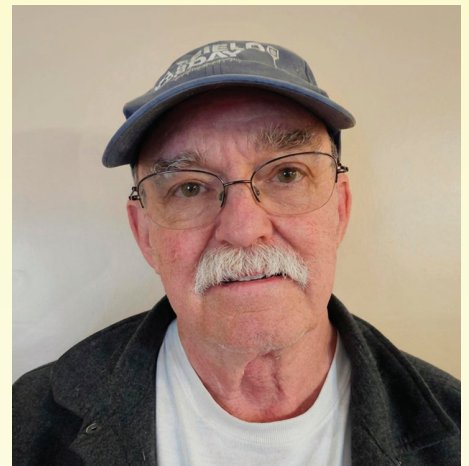
#### PRESIDENT'S LETTER:

Nodes are accessed through a modern web interface, allowing for easy use, without the need to sit right at the node to operate it. TARPEN has been called "Social media for amateur radio". Participating in TARPEN can teach you a vast array of skills, while allowing you to operate with the network as an active user."

June 27 - 28, 2026 - the ARRL / OVH Field Day. The OVH venue this year will again be at the pavilion at the local Nokesville Community Park. This is also an OVH family event, and all family members or other individuals interested or potentially interested in ham radio are invited to attend. There will be a pot luck dinner on Saturday. Portable / temporary ham radio stations will be set up and operated off of generator power. The operations will be in various modes on the HF bands (SSB - voice, CW - morse code, and digital modes) and FM on the VHF / UHF bands. The objective of the radio operation is to make as many two way contacts with other Field Day stations in the USA and Canada as possible during the event, and typically, hundred of contacts are will be made. I first met Art / W1CRO in about 1977/78 when I first moved to western Prince William County from Arlington. Back then, Route 66 was four lanes total, two on each side, just from Gainesville to the Beltway (495), and there was no 66 inside the Beltway. Route 66 was not extended from Gainesville out to Front Royal until about 1980. It was possible back then to drive east on 66 at 6:30 to 8:00 in the morning from Manassas without stopping or backups until about a mile from the Beltway. Very different than now, notwithstanding the massive widening of 66.

Early every weekday morning back then (late 1970s) and later, a bunch of hams from this area initially talked via the OVH 146.97 repeater while driving east on 66 from Manassas, transitioning to other repeaters or direct car to car contact when out of range of the 146.97 repeater. Art was a regular with that group for many years while enroute to his Coast Guard workplace. The phone patch on 146.97 repeater got a lot of use by hams back then, before cellphones, and allowed local calls within PWC which otherwise was long distance from Fairfax County and the rest of the DC metro area.

Art always had something interesting to say or talk about on the radio, he was always very enthusiastic about most aspects of ham radio, and always willing to help other hams, and always very active in the OVH. In his earlier years, he had spent a lot of time at the Chatham, Massachusetts Coast Guard Station on Cape Cod, which for many, many years, now long ago, was a major government East Coast LF and MF CW station, and he had served with the Coast Guard in Vietnam. He had mostly lost his Massachusetts accent with his long time in this area, but it was still detectable when he spoke.

Art will be missed by everyone who knew him.

## OVH at Winterfest

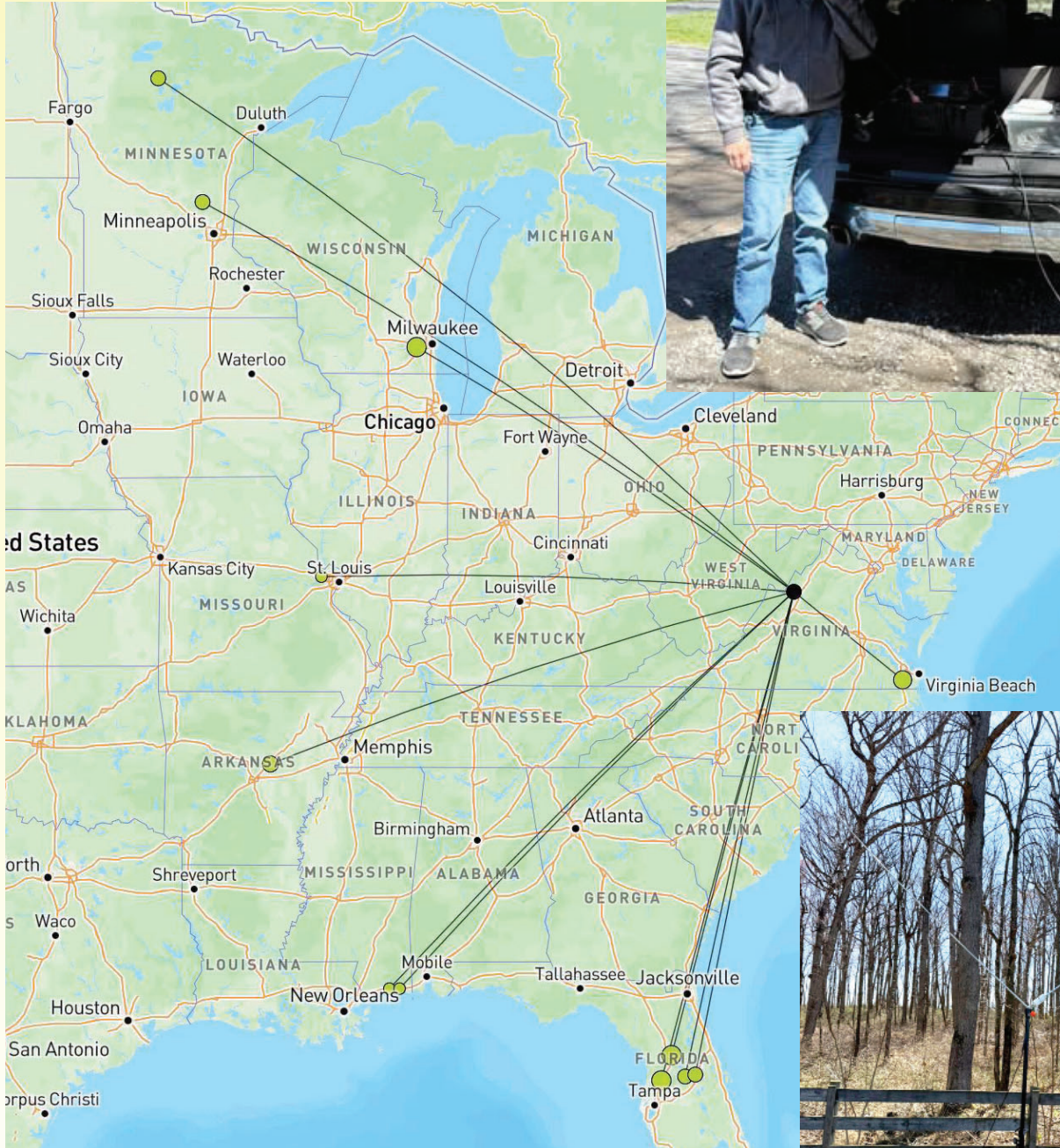
