

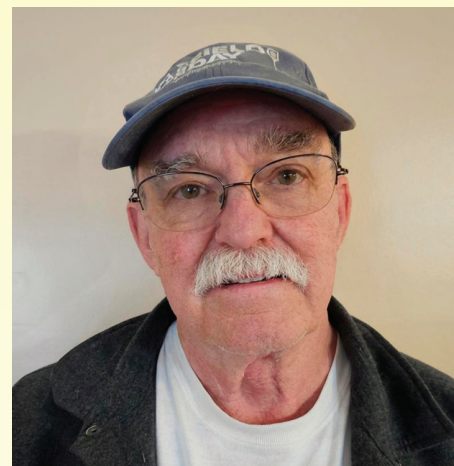

Minutes of the Ole Virginia Hams Amateur Radio Club Meeting held on April 21, 2026:

Vice President, Gil / KM4OZH, called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm on April 21, 2026. The club meeting was held in the training room at the Buckhall Volunteer Fire Department Station. All present stated their names and callsigns.

The program was excellent with a presentation by Jason Rausch / K4APR. Jason brought three identical setups to demonstrate the Terrestrial Amateur Radio Packet Network (TARPN) with 3 nodes. TARPN is essentially an RF packet node-based network and there are currently 38 participants in the experiment. The typical signal change rate is between 1200-9600 baud. The minutes of the March 17, 2026 meeting were approved.

Membership business – Luther /WA3FMO reported one new read-in: Nick Cantos, no license yet. He is interested in voice communications both through hand held and non-hand devices, and CW. Other interests: video games, sports, he's also a Dodgers, Lakers, and Rams fan. Also, Nascar and he's also into gadgets. Vote for him at the next meeting.

Repeater Report – Ken / KE2N noted the repeater is working but some repairs are needed.

Field Day will be held on June 27-28, 2026 at the Nokesville Community Park at 12560 Aden Rd, Nokesville, Virginia. Theresa also advised that more volunteers are needed for Hamfest and Field Day.

OVH RELATED EVENTS

June 20, 2026 (Saturday). The Manassas Hamfest 2026 is now scheduled. Save the date and plan to volunteer to assist the OVH in making this a successful Hamfest. A lot more info about this will be provided for OVH members on the OVH members only email reflector and for everyone on W4OVH.NET over the next several months.

June 27 - 28, 2026 - the ARRL / OVH Field Day. The OVH venue this year will again be at the pavilion at the local Nokesville Community Park. This is also an OVH family event, and all family members or other individuals interested or potentially interested in ham radio are invited to attend. There will be a pot luck dinner on Saturday. Portable / temporary ham radio stations will be set up and operated off of generator power. The operations will be in various modes on the HF bands (SSB - voice, CW - morse code, and digital modes) and FM on the VHF / UHF bands. The objective of the radio operation is to make as many two way contacts with other Field Day stations in the USA and Canada as possible during the event, and typically, hundred of contacts are will be made. There are also usually some other events such as technical lectures, fox (hidden radio transmitter) hunts and balloon launches. Save the date! Watch here for more info as the date gets closer.

OVH VE Session on April 18, 2026

The OVH conducted its second VE exam session using the new ExamTools online system on April 18, 2026. Everything went smoothly and we added two new ham radio operators to our hobby! We also had our first opportunity to offer an exam to a 12-year-old and submit an “ARRL Youth Licensing Grant Program” application. This ARRL program reimburses the \$35 FCC application fee, encouraging those under 18 years of age to become newly licensed ham radio operators.

Four applicants were present at that VE exam session. Two new Technician Class licenses were earned and two hams qualified for an upgrade to General Class.

Holding VE sessions in-person provides valuable face-to-face engagement with prospective OVH members, allowing them to learn more about the club and its activities. All the applicants were interested in finding out more about the OVH’s upcoming Field Day and Hamfest. We also had an opportunity to talk with a previous ham from India (former callsign VU2ADC) who was interested in getting back into ham radio and getting licensed here in the USA.

Thanks to Byron / AK4XR, John / KG4NXT, Bruce / KN4GDX and Lynn / KX4HR for serving as Volunteer Examiners. This was also Lynn’s first VE session!

The next VE session will be held at our Hamfest on June 20, 2026. Since OVH club members will be busy running the event, the Arlington Amateur Radio Club will support the VE session.

Some Possibly Interesting or Useful Information

1. The web site: <https://swrmagazine.org> based in Puerto Rico is now, among other things, publishing a slick, colorful, monthly, free, online flip page ham radio magazine with separate monthly versions in English and Spanish. The current web page also has the May 2026 version in Italian and a prior month (April) version in Japanese readily available online. The editorial content and writing is well done. Worth looking at just for the English version.

2. Some of you will remember that the now defunct, former major US ham magazine and book publisher, CQ Magazine, also published a Spanish language ham magazine with substantial portions of its content drawn from CQ Magazine for many years. I learned that when I purchased a copy in a hotel lobby store in Mexico City in the early 1980’s. It was well put together with content of interest to me so I subscribed to and read it regularly for several years to improve my (reading in) Spanish.

3. Much earlier, when I was a new General class ham seeking new DX contacts on CW, a local ham friend suggested that if I would end my CW calls to stations in Spanish speaking countries with “por favor” (please), that that would increase my callbacks - that had worked for him. I tried it and it did work, but often resulted in a flurry of Spanish text which I could not understand quickly enough for a CW QSO in Spanish. Fortunately, English was and is the international language of ham radio.

4. Another long ago incident reflecting my own cultural / language ignorance and involving ham radio: when I was in early high school, my mother regularly asked me what new DX countries I had contacted. One day I advised I had just had CW contact with a ham in Venezuela named Jesus; that was the first time I had encountered anyone with that name which I thought had been retired or withdrawn from use in biblical times. My mother’s father had been a Methodist Minister, and she was concerned that I had been duped via ham radio by someone, otherwise unknown, claiming to be Jesus. Not until I was able to borrow a Foreign Callbook from a local ham which confirmed the name of YV station’s operator did her concerns subside. I also later got a YV QSL card from that Jesus too.
